

## **Declaration of Conformity to TSCA section 6(h)**

On January 6, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published five final rules prohibiting the processing or distribution into commerce of Phenol, Isopropylated Phosphate (3:1) (PIP 3:1) under Section 6(h) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) as a persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) chemical along with four other PBT chemicals. The 5 substance are:
