



Certificate of Compliance California Proposition 65

Proposition 65, officially known as the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, aims to protect California citizens from significant exposure to chemicals known to the state of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive harm. California Proposition 65 obligates businesses operating in California to provide clear and reasonable warnings before knowingly and intentionally exposing Californians to chemicals that are listed in Proposition 65 List. <http://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65/proposition-65-list>

This Certificate of Compliance certifies that to the best of our current knowledge under normal usage, Dataforth products comply with California Proposition 65 (The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, 1986).
